Year 9 and 12 Lulworth Cove Visit - October 2016

The Geography Department is undertaking a visit to the Lulworth Cove area of Dorset. This is a fantastic opportunity for students to experience coastal processes and landforms first-hand. Fieldwork is an essential part of geographical study and students will collect primary fieldwork data which they will use to investigate coastal landforms on the Jurassic Coast.

The day will involve a variety of supervised data collection activities at two different points along the coast with a short amount of walking between sites. It is essential that students have appropriate clothing, including a waterproof coat and sturdy footwear.

Students should meet at the front of school at 8.55 a.m. where we will travel to Lulworth Cove by coach with fitted seatbelts, returning by 3:20 pm. There will be limited opportunities to purchase food and drink, therefore students should be provided with a packed lunch. The cost of the trip is £6.50 which covers hire of the coach and insurance.

Please note, there will be some trips or activities which the school cannot charge for, but which the school considers would be beneficial to the students. In this case the school may ask for voluntary contributions. No student will be excluded from the activity or treated differently because they do not make a contribution. If voluntary contributions are not sufficient then it may be that the planned activity or trip cannot go ahead.
