- County lines is also known as Criminal Exploitation.
- It is an illegal drug business, whereby gangs recruit and use children and young people to move drugs and money for them.
- Children as young as 10 years plus are being recruited, often using social media.
- They are exploited and forced to carry drugs between different places, usually on foot or using a push bike.
- They can also be made to go on trains or coaches to different parts of the country.
- They are also forced to sell drugs to local users.

CRIMINAL EXPLOITATION

It is a form of modern slavery – Gangs take advantage of anyone they can manipulate and brainwash.

Young people are being forced to work under the control of highly organised criminals.

Young people are promised money, protection and a feeling they belong to something, but that soon stops and the abuse starts, leaving them feeling trapped and scared.

Forced young people to leave their homes, go missing and are made to stay in trap houses and drug dens. Forced to hold guns or knives as well.

FACTS

- In 2018, the NCA identified 720 county line gangs in England and Wales. Beginning of 2019, they identified 2000 county line gangs with the majority originating from London, followed by Liverpool.
- However, the most recent figure is 2700 county line gangs.
- National Crime Agency has estimated 46,000 young people are currently being exploited in England.
