# Uniform Standards

- From September 2026 the Huish Episcopi Polo shirt and shorts/skort will be compulsory.

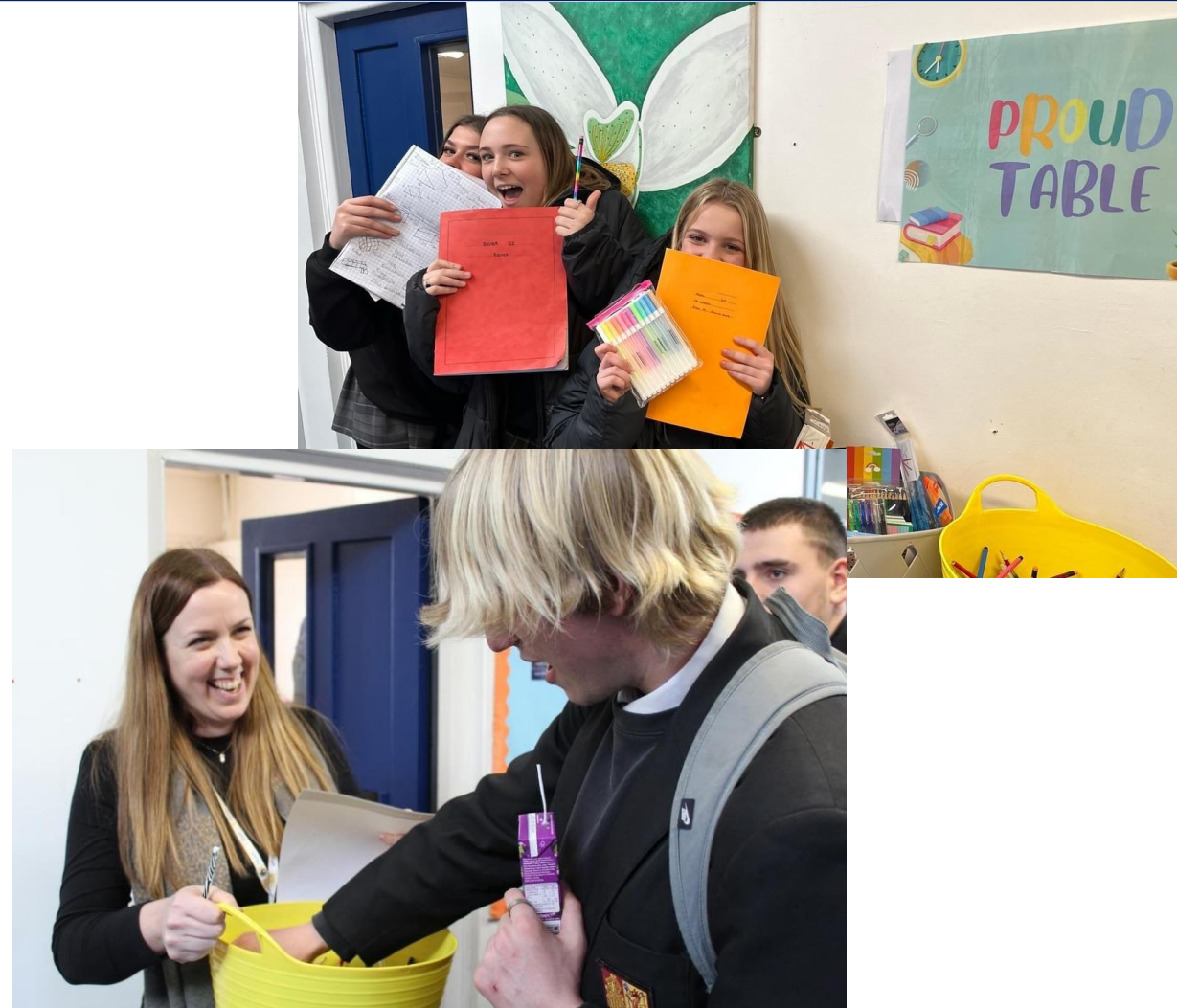


- Must be running trainer style. Shoes do not need to be branded and can be any colour but must be of a similar style to the ones pictured.
