Year 9 Science

In Science, all Year 9 students are starting their GCSE course now that we have returned to school for the new year. All pupils will study B1 Cell Biology, C1 Atomic Structure and the Periodic Table and P3 Particle Model of Matter.

At the end of Year 9, pupils will be assessed and assigned to appropriate ability sets for the start of Year 10. For this reason, we do not recommend buying revision guides just yet.
